Immerse yourself in Kanuga's pristine beauty with a guided two-hour backcountry tour via an all-terrain vehicle. Points of interest include the old logging roads along Corn Mountain, a stop at Sunset Point, and a leisurely descent through our peaceful mountain valley.

Enjoy an informative guided tour via headset radio. Highlights include:

- The natural history of the land
- Facts about wild plants and WNC's unique ecosystem
- Kanuga's forest management strategies
- Guided explorations and contemplations about our natural world



Times: 10 a.m.-12 p.m. and 2 p.m.-4 p.m.

Cost: \$30 per person; tours limited to five guests. Early registration is suggested.

Location: Groups meet in the inn's atrium for a safety briefing and helmet fitting.

Please arrive 10 minutes early.

Ages: Adults through children. Children may join if they are over 80 pounds, no longer require a booster seat, and can fit into a helmet properly.

Recommendations: Please wear weather-appropriate attire and closed-toe shoes.

Come prepared for the weather: a full water bottle, sunglasses, a rain coat, or any additional items you may need for two hours of backcountry exploration.
