Skip year policy: Traditional occupants may skip one summer every five years. Adult children of the traditional occupants may attend in their stead. Please contact us directly if you would like to discuss transferring the traditional occupant status to an adult child or sibling.

Sales Tax: North Carolina sales and use tax of 6.75% is not reflected in lodging and meal rates.

Children Under 3: A morning nursery is available Monday - Friday at a fee of \$20 per child per day. Limited space available.

Minimum Stay: Cottages & Guest Houses rented by the full week. Inn Rooms require a 4-night minimum stay (except for week # 7).

Additional Financial Assistance: Please find, print, and mail the financial assistance request form located at kanuga.org under the Summer Guest Period tab.

Referral Incentive: Both referrer and candidate receive up to \$315 per referral. In order to qualify, candidate must rent an accommodation and must not have rented an accommodation at Guest Period in the previous 3 years.

Cancellation Policy and Fees: In the event of cancellation, notice must be sent to Kanuga by mail, fax or email.

- Cancellations made 60 days or more before the event will forfeit any non-refundable deposits.
- Cancellations made at least one week (seven calendar days) prior to arrival will forfeit lodging fees. Meals will not be charged.
- Cancellations made less than one week prior to arrival will be charged for meals for each registered attendee who cancels (\$125 for adults, \$100 for youth, and \$75 for children); or the full daily meal rate if applicable.
- Adjustments to attendee meal packages, within 14 days before arrival, will be charged at the daily meal rate and will not qualify for the week rate.

Deposit and Payment Information: The deposit is \$250 per Inn Room and \$500 for Cottages and Guest Houses. Deposits are nonrefundable and non-transferable after they are received and processed. After the initial deposit, your remaining balance will be paid in two installments (see schedule below). 60 days before arrival 50% of the remaining balance is due; 30 days before arrival, your remaining balance and attendee list are due. Sales tax will be included for each payment. Each payment is nonrefundable and non-transferable after it is received. **The full amount including meal packages and taxes are due 30 days before arrival.**
