FOR GOOD HEALTH:

- Please note: All the parameters listed below are subject to change. If CDC, the state of North Carolina, or Henderson County Department of Health COVID requirements change, this covenant will be revised for compliance.
- Please bring face masks or other facial covering, blankets for picnics or use outdoor, sanitation wipes, personal hand sanitizer
- By June, 2021, Kanuga will be allowed to provide 3 meals a day. All meals will be a served buffet with staggered entry times. Limited in-door and socially distanced dining will be available. Guests are encouraged to take advantage of the plethora of outdoor dining options available, and/or take the meal back to your accommodation. All meals will be available for take-out.
- Kanuga will not provide pillows. Please bring your own.
- Kanuga is planning for 50 participants being in-person during the Gathering, but has the capacity to safely gather 125, per NCDHHS guidelines, in the Balthis building. This number represents 33 % of fire code capacity, with constant air ventilation via HVAC fan system and opening all side wall doors for further ventilation. Maintaining social distancing will be required, and wearing masks is required when entering/exiting and/or moving about in a building, and/or when social distance cannot be maintained.
- Participants will be encouraged to be vaccinated. If not vaccinated, they will be encouraged to obtain a negative molecular PCR COVID test, taken no fewer than three days prior to arrival, and present these test results at check-in. Kanuga will request of all participants a four-day quarantine from non-vaccinated or unmasked people prior to arrival. The Christian Formation Planning Team will have all been vaccinated.
- Staff Policy: 100% of Kanuga's staff has been vaccinated, although we will not require vaccination. Daily health screenings and temperature checks of staff are required.
