



## KANUGA TRAILS CONSERVANCY GUIDELINES

Please help preserve and protect Kanuga's forests as you enjoy them, by following these guidelines.

### PARKING

- Park only in designated parking areas. Vehicles left along roadways may block access for maintenance, road crews or restrict driver visibility. Designated parking areas are:
  - *Camp Kanuga parking lot (when camp is not in session)*
  - *The parking lot by the Inn*
  - *The Harold House parking lot (may be limited in the summer)*
- Please place your KTC car hangtag visible on your vehicle's rearview mirror while hiking. This will notify staff to "keep a look out" for hikers in case of an emergency.

### PETS

- If you bring your pet with you, dogs must be leashed, under control, and picked up after. Additionally, pets must be kept out of buildings and away from lodging and the central areas of our three campuses.

### HIKING

- Most of our trails are for hikers only; if you would like to mountain bike on property please purchase a pass at Ride Kanuga and utilize their mountain bike specific trails.
- Many of our camp and conference guests use the trails regularly; please share the trail with them.

### FISHING

- Your KTC pass also gives you the ability to fish the ponds and lakes on property. Please note the following:
  - *Any fishing in Kanuga Lake must be done well away from swimming areas.*
  - *All fishing is catch and release only.*
  - *Ned Ball Pond is for fly fishing only.*

### OTHER

- KTC membership grants you access to hiking and fishing only. Swimming or boating of any kind on Kanuga property is prohibited. The gym as well as the climbing tower and ropes courses are for registered guests of Kanuga only.

### GENERAL

- Please "pack out" all trash and food items. This keeps Kanuga looking beautiful and encourages wild animals to go elsewhere for food. In addition to keeping up with your own trash, please help us keep trails clear by picking up any litter you see on trail.
- If a staff member asks who you are tell them your name and that you are a KTC member.
- Kanuga is home to rare and endangered species of plants and animals. To protect them, please try to remain on the trail and be mindful of where you step off trail.
- Please follow *Leave No Trace* principals on Kanuga property.
