As we welcome conferences, Kanuga is committed to providing a safe environment that aligns with guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and other leading health and industry experts.

Masking

Following CDC guidelines for areas **with *low transmission**, guests are **not required** to wear a face covering in Kanuga's indoor public spaces. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Kanuga does require masking for staff working in guest-forward areas while serving food and beverage. If transmission rates in Henderson County, the region, or CDC guidelines change, our policy will be revised accordingly.

* Transmission Rate Guidelines

LOW: Face coverings are not required by guests. While serving food and beverage, staff will be masked. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so.

MEDIUM: All staff wear masks in indoor public spaces. Guests at high risk for severe illness or who are not up-to-date on vaccines wear masks in indoor public spaces. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so.

High: All staff wear masks in indoor public spaces. All guests, whether vaccinated or not, wear masks in indoor public spaces. All guests participating in program provide proof of up-to-date vaccination status or proof of negative rapid antigen test or PCR test, taken no more than 72 hours before arrival.
